This year the exhibition is based on the theme "More than Icons" which is a concept that challenges Asia's recent obsession with creating architectural icons.

The exhibition will be presented through 4 sub-themes, namely "To Engage," "To Feel," "To Sustain" and "To Craft," in specially designed sets for each sub-theme.

"To Engage" - Featured works focus on the interaction between users and architecture.

"To Feel" - Hallmark of the featured projects lie in evoking emotions and imagination within architectural spaces (e.g. atmospheres for prayer and mourning)

"To Sustain" - Projects exhibited show dedication of the ethics and responsibilities of both environment and social aspects of our designers.

"To Craft" - Featured works showcase the creativity of designers in aspect of construction and the ability to express tactile qualities of materials in architecture.
